The library is regarded as an essential component of an educational institution and a fundamental pillar of a thriving community. The institution has inaugurated a library housing a collection of 232 volumes. The library exemplifies inclusivity by representing a wide range of personalities and effectively meets the requirements and desires of the students and teachers. The current library has a collection of 2148 textbooks, 33 magazines, and around 250 tale books. The library offers a variety of resources including textbooks, reference books, periodicals, bound volume journals, student research projects, and a selection of English and Marathi narrative books. Additionally, there is a collection of CDs accessible. The books in the library are organised and categorised according to subject. The available subjects include paediatrics, obstetrics, gynaecology, medical surgical nursing, pharmacology, pathology, nursing management & administration, sociology, nursing research, ENT & ophthalmology, biochemistry, microbiology, community health nursing, fundamental of nursing, nursing foundations, psychiatry and psychology, anatomy, physiology, computer, communication and environmental nursing, critical care nursing, and orthopaedics. The library began the purchase process for the journal collection. The library expanded its collection of electronic journals starting in 2018. The library obtained national and international e-journals from renowned publications. Students and faculty members may conveniently access links using their Mauli IDs, whether they are on campus or off campus. The books and magazines are obtained from well-known Indian and worldwide publishers and suppliers. The Nursing Library is affiliated with the main medical college library, allowing access to additional resources. Furthermore, all 32 libraries at Somaiya are networked, enabling users to access library sources and materials from any of them. Users may avail themselves of the advantages of loan access facilities and current

access services offered by any library. A distinct library website is provided, which includes a web gateway including various materials, as well as access to Pearsons e-library. Mauli College of Nursing has an extensive array of materials accessible to its customers. The details are provided below: Currently, the library lacks any collections of manuscripts or rare books.
