**4.5.2:** There are established systems and procedures for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities - laboratory, library, sports facilities, computers, classrooms etc.

Mauli College of Nursing guarantees the proper maintenance and utilisation of its infrastructure and facilities via regular inventory management, stock verification, and maintenance activities carried out through annual maintenance contracts and repairs. There is a well-established procedure for gathering the necessary materials. The institution guarantees the provision of an in/out pass system for any equipment that is brought into or removed from the premises. The installation of CCTV cameras at different locations also guarantees a decrease in pilferage. The College has implemented a structured procedure for addressing any grievances pertaining to the upkeep and repair of physical facilities and equipment. Complaints may be sent using the Google site 'itcomplaints.org'. The relevant authority resolves the issue within 2 days, and the college responds with a comment through the same portal when the problem has been fixed. The facility consists of six labs, including the Advanced Nursing lab, FON lab, CHN lab, MCH lab, AV Aids lab, and Nutrition lab. Teachers oversee the management and upkeep of issuance and return registers, which are kept by each Lab In Charge. Inventory audits are conducted on a yearly basis. Rules and rules are established to govern the utilisation of laboratories. The library offers a diverse collection of books, including textbooks from many disciplines, memoirs, literature, journals, computer-related publications, and theses. Additionally, it provides access to electronic periodicals. The books are organised methodically. Both teachers and students using the library and are required to record their entrance in the register. Each individual has a library card. A register called the "accession book" is kept to keep a record of materials in the library. Additionally, there is software available specifically designed for this purpose. Stock inventory is conducted at regular intervals. Strict adherence to protocols governing the issuance and retrieval process is maintained. Sports Facilities — Students have access to a wide range of outdoor and indoor sports facilities.

Students and staff participate in many sports contests organised by the Mauli Sports Academy, MUHS. The circulars are received by either email or postal mail. The Sports In Charge has the responsibility of disseminating sports-related information to the relevant individuals. Communication may occur either via a WhatsApp group or through spoken conversation.

Computers - The college has a total of 6 computers for student and instructor use, as well as 5 computers specifically for non-teaching faculty. Each class is equipped with an own laptop, and the maintenance of the computers is contracted out to other service providers. The IT department promptly resolves issues.

Classroom - All the classrooms are well ventilated. There are a total of two air-conditioned classrooms, with each classroom equipped with closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras. There are smart boards in two classes. Each classroom is equipped with its own notice board and LCD projectors. Initiatives like as Swachh Bharat Abhiyan inspire students to proactively maintain cleanliness and orderliness in their classrooms. The class coordinator and the student class representative have the responsibility to report any difficulties pertaining to the upkeep of the classroom. There are laws and regulations in place to guarantee that the classroom and labs are efficiently used and properly maintained. The institution prioritises preventive measures over reactive solutions and endeavours to maintain and manage the infrastructure and equipment to maximise their effectiveness and efficiency.
