Mauli College organises programmes aimed at broadening the students' reach and worldview. These activities aim to boost their professional, educational, social, and cultural growth. In addition, we organise recreational, cultural, and sporting activities. Therefore, the institution aims to enhance the student's academic and extracurricular aspects that contribute to the development of their personality. The children are incentivized, inspired, and financially supported to participate in diverse activities at the unit, state, and national levels.
